PROJECT INSPIRATION

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### SUPPLIES

#### **PAPER**

12" x 10 1/2" piece of card stock Patterned Paper

#### **OTHER**

Magnets Velcro

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### STEP 1:

Start with a 12" x 10 1/2" piece of card stock. Keep the piece you cut off to use later. Along the 10 1/2" side, score at 1", 2", 8 1/2" and 9 1/2".



### STEP 2:

Next you will score along the 12" side at 3 1/4", 4 1/4", 8 3/4" and 9 3/4".



### INSTRUCTIONS

#### STEP 3:

Cut out the following areas to form the flaps of the box. Cut at the 8 3/4" score line to form a tab.



#### STEP 4:

It is best to decorate, before you assemble your box. You can round the corners of the flaps if you like. Attaching adhesive where indicated.



### INSTRUCTIONS

#### STEP 5:

Your panels are going to measure:

Middle panel - 6.25" x 4.25", the second layer 5 3/4" x 3 3/4". Top panel (the larger of the two edge panels) - 6 1/4" x 3", second layer 5 3/4" x 2 1/2"

Bottom panel - 6 1/4" by 2", second layer 5 3/4" by 1 1/2"

Decorate the top fold of the box, 6 1/4" x 3/4" and second layer was 5 3/4" x 1/4" and the side folds which were 4 1/4" x 3/4" and 3 3/4" x 1/4" to keep in proportion with the rest of the panels.

#### STEP 6:

Pull up the small tabs first and secure on the inside of the box.



I used magnets to close the finished box. As an alternative you could use velcro dots or make a belly band from the left over 1 1/2" strip you cut from the original 12x12 cardstock.

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### STEP 7:

You score the belly band at 2 3/4", 3 3/4", 8 1/4" and 9 1/4" marks and it will wrap quite easily around the box and secure. Then decorate the band.


