INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:

To create this A7-sized card, cut the card front panel, 5" wide X 7" tall and the back panel 5" wide X 7-1/2" tall. Score the back panel on the short side at 1/2" from the top of the panel. Set it aside for later. On the front panel, die cut the middle-sized Rounded Heart die from the panel and set it aside for later. Stamp the "You Are Loved" wreath design around the heart, using Pinefeather green ink. Stamp the largest flower from the floral set in Melon Berry, applying more ink to the base of each blossom. You can achieve this by touching the pad's surface to the image's base.

STEP 2:

Stamp additional detailed layers to the melon flowers using Canyon Clay (petals) and Americana (centers). Using other flowers from the "You Are Loved" set, stamp various blossoms on the wreath using Lilac Grace and Limeade Ice with Simply Chartreuse ink layered details. Splatter dark brown watercolor paint around the wreath using a fan brush. Allow time for it to dry.

STEP 3:

Apply Prairie Grass ink to the stem layer only of the larger single leaf image in the wreath set. Stamp around the wreath, creating an airy, yet full wreath. This fine leafy image can be stamped over blossoms with its thin and open shape. Use a tiny Post-It note to create a mask to stamp the leafy design behind the flowers, too.

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 4:

Stamp three leafy branches in Ripe Avocado ink and three berry trios in Scarlet Jewel on white cardstock. Die cut the images using the coordinating dies and attach the berries to the branches using glue. Stamp and cut additional flowers to layer over the wreath.

STEP 5:

Use a fine-tip black marker and a white Gelly Roll pen to add highlight and calyx-like details to the berries to make them look more rounded and real. (See circle closeup for details.)

STEP 6:

Attach the berry branch leaves to the wreath using glue. Attach the additional flowers using foam tabs to make them stand out from the wreath background. Stamp the "Best Wishes" sentiment below the wreath in black ink.

STEP 7:

Stamp the "love" word from the Forever and Always set in Scarlet Jewel on white cardstock. Die cut the word. Lightly blend Melon Berry to the heart cutout from step 1. Glue the word to the heart, angling it upward. Use the front panel window as a guide to attach the heart to the back inside panel so they match up. Stamp a verse from the same stamp set, right below the heart.

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 8:

Add double sided tape to the 1/2" folded flap on the back panel. Attach the front and back panels together, matching up the heart and panels.

STEP 9:

Using a purple marker or a Copic Sketch Marker in V09, add more blossoms around the airy leaves to add volume and fill in gaps. The deep color also adds more depth to the color story.
