INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:

Using Ranger Distress Oxide ink in Mowed Lawn, use a blender brush to stencil the trees on the pink cardstock. Add some red to the design by hand coloring random red dots using a red marker. For example, use R46 for the bottom and RV02 for the top of the dot and blend. Add a dot of white using a Gelly Roll pen at the top of each one and some shading in W3 and W1 below each dot to make them appear dimensional.

STEP 2:

Stamp the two cookie options using Classic Kraft Ink for the cookie bases. Stamp details using a slightly darker brown for the second layer. If you don't have a darker version, you can stamp in the same color and use a marker to darken the edge such as Copic Markers in E57 and E55 as shown here. Stamp the frosting in Sweet Blush and the chips in Dark Chocolate. Enhance the cookies by adding "browned" edges at the bottom (Copics: E57, E55, E53) and in the crevices (E53) of the top. Darken the edges of the frosting (RV55, RV02) for a bit of a shadow to make it look thick. Use the Gelly Roll pen in white to add highlight marks for contrast on the tops of the cookies.

STEP 3:

Attach the stenciled background to a 5" X 7" card base made from Stamper's Select White cardstock (i.e., 10" wide X 7" tall piece of cardstock scored at 5" from short side.)

STEP 4:

Stamp the following:

- Cup: Hibiscus Burst Ink on Sweet Blush cardstock
- Cocoa: Dark Chocolate Ink on Stamper's Select White cardstock
- Marshmallows: Fine Linen Ink on Stamper's Select White cardstock, True Black and Orange Zest ink for face.
- Peppermint Sticks, peppermint rounds and sentiment: Pure Poppy Ink on Stamper's Select White cardstock. Stamp the snowflakes on the cup in Pure Poppy, too.

Die cut the items listed above using the coordinating dies as well as these items from colored cardstock:

- Holly leaves: New Leaf (three sets)
- Berries from Stamper's Select White (two sets)
- Branches from Dark Chocolate (two sets)

Color the berries using shades of red (e.g., Copic's R89, R59, R46 and R14.). Blend Ranger Distress Oxide ink in Mowed Lawn and Rustic Wilderness on edges of the holly leaves for more depth.

STEP 5:

Arrange the design using the branches as the "frame" for the design. Position the die cut sentiment at the top to ensure there is room for it. Use foam tabs to secure the sentiment in place and glue to secure the branches.

STEP 6:

Position the assembled cup in the design as the focal point. Use foam tabs to secure it in place.

STEP 7:

Position the holly leaves around the cup to make the pink cup stand out from the pink background.

STEP 8:

Add the remaining images to the design, keeping the cup as the focal point. Add a rhinestone gem sticker to the snowflake on the cup. Add white snow specks to the images using a white Gelly Roll pen. Add white highlights to the berries at the top of each one. Add some pink coloring to the sentiment letters to unite the pinks and reds (e.g., Copic RV55, RV02). To finish, Stamp a red peppermint border at the bottom of the card using the border image from the Vintage Holiday Flair Stamp set and Pure Poppy Ink.
