## INSTRUCTIONS

### STEP 1:

To create this A7-sized card, cut one panel, 5" wide X 7" tall from Stamper's Select white cardstock. Cut the card base 10" wide X 7" tall from the same white cardstock, score down the middle and set it aside.

Using the Weather it Together stencil, create a whimsical border by positioning the stencil with the round part of the design facing in towards the card center, like a scallop edge. Stencil using Summer Sunrise, Harvest Gold or any yellow ink and repeat the pattern all the way around the perimeter of the card front.

When dry, hand color small flowers inside the design using pinks, greens and orange markers such as Copics YR68, YR65, RV55, RV02, YG67, YG03. These are just little whisps of the marker!

TIP: Use two coordinating colors for each flower to add more depth.

### STEP 2:

Stamp and cut the umbrella parts, flower and bow, using the images in the Weather it Together stamp and die sets and assemble the umbrellas.

For the pink-handled umbrella, use a marker (YR68, YR65, RV55, RV02, YG67, YG03) to add bold, custom stripes to the umbrella. Use gray markers (C3 and C1) to add shading over the stripes at the seam sections to highlight the round shape of each umbrella section. Add the orange die cut over the stripes for a dramatic, layered look.

**Tip:** To add more interest and contrast, add additional detailing to the umbrellas using a white Gelly Roll pen such as faux stitches, white dots, and white highlight marks.

# INSTRUCTIONS

## **STEP 3:**

Stamp and die cut a sentiment (such as the "Welcome sunshine" sentiment chosen for this card) using the Thoughts of Spring stamps and dies.

## **STEP 4:**

Attach the umbrellas and the sentiment using foam tabs to the card front to make them stand out. Add a pearl to the middle of the umbrella flower, and sequins and an acrylic butterfly above the sentiment. Attach the card front to the card base to complete it.

**Tip:** The Thoughts of Spring sentiment set has great coordinating sentiments to stamp on the inside of the card, too!
