INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:

Blend the Sunflower Garden Stencil onto a panel of white cardstock using Melon Berry, Pure Poppy, Scarlet Jewel, Summer Sunrise and Simply Chartreuse inks with blending brushes. Die-cut the panel with the Handmade Quilt Cover Die.

STEP 2:

Trim the stenciled panel and layer over a panel of Pure Poppy cardstock and an A2 panel of red and white gingham pattern paper.

STEP 3:

Die-cut the smallest oval in the Love to Layer: Ovals Die Set from Pure Poppy cardstock, the largest die in the Love to Layer: Pinked Square Die Set from red & white gingham paper and the largest die in the Reflections: August Die Set from vellum. Trim the gingham paper and adhere it, along with the oval, to the vellum, using the background to determine placement. (the vellum is not adhered to the background yet)

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 4:

Die-cut the pieces for the cheesecake from Vintage Cream, Pure Poppy, Melon Berry, Sweet Blush, Simply Chartreuse and white cardstock using the Sweet As Pie Die Set. Add shading with ink and details with OLO markers and a white gel pen, then adhere the pieces together. Stamp the sentiment from the This Is Big Sentiments: Celebrate Stamp Set onto white cardstock with Pure Poppy Ink, cut out with the Coordinating Die and trim into a narrow banner. I also die-cut three more layers of "celebrate" from heavyweight white cardstock and layered them behind the stamped one. Adhere all the die-cuts to the vellum with liquid glue, except the sentiment strip. It was popped up with foam tape.

STEP 5:

Apply liquid adhesive to the back of the vellum, behind the die-cuts and adhere to the background panel.

STEP 6:

Add Moonshine Sequins to finish off the card.
