INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:

This card is so easy to create, although it may look time consuming. First start by die cutting your Simple Tree from heavy cardboard. Tear fabric into 1" strips. Starting at the top of your tree, wrap ribbon around the tree and tie in a tight knot in the center. Trim ends to taper down from the top to the bottom, to mimic the shape of the tree.

STEP 2:

Repeat all the way down the tree, mixing in scraps of trim and seam binding in between fabric strips. Once tree is complete, add die cut snowflakes, Moonshine sequins, and buttons to embellish.

STEP 3:

Cut a smaller Simple Tree from heavy cardboard. Using a wide piece of trim, wrap around tree, adhere ends securely on back, and adhere Pom Pom trim around edges.

STEP 4:

Die cut Tiers of Cheer tag and Tag Its tag. Stamp smaller tag using images from Tier of Cheer. Layer tags together using a safety pin and adhere die cut and stamped sentiment. Fasten safety pin to tree.

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 5:

Die cut Border Bling: Snow Flakes from pink cardstock. Adhere over a silver cardstock card base. Stamp Weathered Wood Background onto a die cut Love to Layer: Oval. Layer a vellum oval over the top and adhere both to center of card.

STEP 6:

Die cut Love to Layer: Scalloped Circle from white glitter cardstock and adhere to center of card, followed by die cut Snowflake Banners. Attach a strip of pink velvet cardstock across the center of card.

STEP 7:

Adhere completed trees to center of card and embellish with die cut snowflakes and Moonshine sequins to finish.
