# INSTRUCTIONS

## **STEP 1:**

Begin applying stencils to your Vintage Cream background, cut using the Border Bling: Skinny Embossed Frames dies. I started with the berries and then built from there.

## **STEP 2:**

After each layer of stencil has been applied, lightly sponge on Bright Buttercup ink, peeking through the branches, just as sunlight might. Spritz with water and Distress Spray to age.

## **STEP 3:**

Die cut a Love to Layer: Torn Edges die from Vintage Cream cardstock. Lightly sponge Aqua Mist ink over the upper surface to resemble the sky. Adhere to center of card.

## **STEP 4:**

Stamp a die cut Psalm Reflections: February bracket using a sentiment from the Just Sentiments: Spring Blessings stamp set and adhere to the center of the card.

## **STEP 5:**

Sponge color over die cut eggs and grass. Adhere beneath the sentiment.

# INSTRUCTIONS

**STEP 6:**

Die cut and stamp flowers from the Easter Egg-travaganza stamp set and adhere surrounding sentiment, springing up from the eggs. Embellish with adhesive gems and stickles to finish.
