INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:

From white cardstock, cut base frame using the Border Bling: Tin Stitch die. Stamp flowers, from Wreath Favor Box Sentiments, around outside of frame. Adhere frame to Harvest Gold card base and round corners if desired.

STEP 2:

From Harvest Gold cardstock, cut a rectangle using the Nesting Basics: Pierced Rectangles die. Using the Stencil Basics: Hexagon, stencil hexagons using Bright Buttercup and Summer Sunrise ink. Adhere to center of card.

STEP 3:

From white cardstock, cut a Love to Layer: Scalloped Circle. Stamp wreath in center of circle and using berries from Floral Christmas, stamp a cluster of berries in coordinating ink colors near upper right corner of wreath.

STEP 4:

Cut a strip of Bitty Big Spring Moss paper to fit across card, and adhere just below center.

STEP 5:

Stamp sentiment near lower left corner using Olive Twist ink. Stamp and die cut flowers and leaves from Wreath Favor Box Sentiments and adhere using dimensional adhesive over berry clusters. Adhere completed circle to center of card.

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 6:

Die cut daisies from Into the Blooms 1 die collection and lightly sponge petals with Harvest Gold or Bright Buttercup ink. Cut centers and color with a coordinating marker and add dots using a marker or colored pencil. Assemble flowers and adhere near upper right and lower left corners.

STEP 7:

Embellish with adhesive gems or sequins to finish.
